

REVISED CATEGORIES FOR VIOLENCE PROBE QUESTION “Why didn’t (incident/dispute) get any worse?”

NOTE: This listing is for illustrative purposes and provides examples of the types of statements which would prompt the interviewer to code a particular response. The values for each code are underlined. These values are immediately followed by a list of statement examples.

| 00. <u>No additional response</u> | 08. <u>Account giving (involves verbal communication)</u> we talked problem out because what she was saying made sense he apologized |
| 01. <u>Didn’t want to hurt</u> wasn’t trying to hurt her didn’t want to hurt him if I fought harder, he would have been hurt | 09. <u>Delusion/hallucination related</u> the voices stopped |
| 02. <u>Didn’t want to fight</u> wasn’t in the mood to fight didn’t feel good to punch someone | 10. <u>3rd party intervention (use no additional code)</u> police came my brother broke it up |
| 03. <u>Did enough/hurt enough/satisfied/self-defense</u> didn’t want it to get worse felt like I did enough wasn’t worth it to hurt him anymore didn’t want to cause any more trouble stopped after I saw I hurt him | 11. <u>Lacking means/ability</u> because I hit my head and was intoxicated because he was drunk and couldn’t respond I didn’t have a weapon or I would have used it I was trying to kill him, missed when I shot at him I was too tired |
| 04. <u>Relationship</u> because he’s my baby’s father we were friends I kind of liked the guy, just wanted to teach him a lesson I had my daughter with me I love her | 12. <u>Miscellaneous</u> our tempers settled down I saw myself flipping out and said “stop it!” |
| 05. <u>Subject afraid of harm to self</u> I got scared and backed off I saw he had a gun and got scared I could have bled to death | 97. <u>Refused</u> 98. <u>NA</u> 99. <u>Missing information</u> |
| 06. <u>Subject concerned with consequences</u> <u>(other than harm to self)</u> I was on probation and didn’t want any trouble I could have gone to jail If I shot, I knew the consequences I got scared because I could have killed him | |
| 07. <u>Victim backed off</u> victim was afraid and backed off victim knew if he stayed, he’d be killed victim knew I was high so he backed off | |
