Coding Manual

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INTRODUCTION

History

The subject follow-up data collection period for the MacArthur Risk Assessment Study began immediately following the subject's discharge from an inpatient mental health treatment facility. The subject follow-up period lasted one-year post-discharge. This follow-up year was segmented into five periods and subject data were collected at each point by means of a subject interview. These interviews consisted of patient self-reports. Patients were recontacted in the community by the research interviewers and interviewed five times (every ten weeks) over one year from the date of discharge. Patient interviews were in person (89%) or by telephone (11%). Patients were paid for their participation. Arrest and re-hospitalization records were also obtained.

Organization

All subject follow-up interview data (follow-ups 1-5) are contained in one SPSS data file named "folldsubj". **Variables for the first follow-up interview begin with the letter "a", variables for subsequent follow-up interviews (i.e., follow-up interviews 2-5) begin with the letters "b", "c", "d", and "e", respectively.** The naming conventions for all of the variables across follow-ups are the same EXCEPT for the first letter as indicated above. The second section of the code book contains variable information for additional follow-up "add-on" instruments. Unlike the variables in the first part of the code book (which were repeated at EVERY follow-up), these instruments were only administered at selected follow-up sessions. Prior to each of these measures, there is a brief explanation of how and when the data from each scale were collected, as well as more detailed coding information. Also, please note that the "a-e" naming conventions DO NOT APPLY in this section. Those conventions only refer to variables contained in the first part of the code book.

Special note regarding calculated variables

For many of the "add-on" scales mentioned above, additional variables were calculated from the data collected. Calculated variables that relate directly to any of the "add-on" instruments are listed in the corresponding "add-on" section. All remaining calculated variables for the follow-up period are listed in the last section of the code book (i.e., Other Calculated Variables). Some variables were only calculated for certain follow-up data. For each variable listed in this section, the follow-up(s) to which the calculated variable pertains is clearly indicated in bold typeface immediately following the variable description.

Notes

In some cases (especially in violence screens), there are multiple repeating variables present in the coding manual. Throughout each of the interviews, variable information was often collected in grid format. Whenever there are two variable names listed under the same heading and the names are separated by the word "to" (e.g., v2.2.1b to v2.2.7b), this represents a repeated variable. Variables will always repeat in ascending numerical order throughout the specified range. Throughout the coding manuals, references are commonly made to a particular sets of codes (e.g., See CRIME CLASSIFICATION CODES). These code sheets are located in the MAC CODES folder.

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SOCIAL SUPPORT

Social Network Inventory numbers (SNI#) < 40 were assigned to those names collected at the BASELINE interview. SNI#'s > 40 were assigned to those names collected at Follow-up Interviews 1-5. Names collected at Follow-ups 1-5 were also recorded on the Social Network Inventory (SNI), but were weighted according to the follow-up interview # in which they were obtained. The actual (vs. weighted) SNI# can be obtained using the following formula:*

* Follow-up 1 = 40 + SNI#	Formula: <u>SNI#</u>	<u>Product</u> = Follow-up Interview#
Follow-up 2 = 80 + SNI#	40	<u>Remainder</u> = Actual SNI#
